The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in connection with

Mahila P. S. Case No. 30 of 2018 registered under Sections 341,
498A, 306, 511, 354, 504, 506 and 323 read with 34 of the

Indian Penal Code and 3 & 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Considering that the main allegation in the first

information report is against the father-in-law of the informant,

in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below, the

petitioners, who happens to be the mother-in-law and sister-in-

law respectively, are directed to be released on bail on



furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No. 30 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
