ORAL ORDER

3 01-02-2019 The learned counsel for the respondents submits that
without any suspension order just on the pretext of alleged
pendency of an enquiry, the salary of the petitioner has been

Having regard to the stand taken by the respondents, the respondents are directed to release the salary of the petitioner within a period of three weeks from today, failing which the District Magistrate, Kaimur shall not draw his salary.
