2 22-07-2019 This application under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner for directing and commanding the respondent authorities to release the motorcycle bearing registration no.BR04M-0638, Engine No.DHZCCC14638 which has illegally been seized in connection with Manjhi P.S. Case No.106 of 2018 registered under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.
