encroachment made over the public land.

This Court is of the opinion that the writ petition is

not maintainable inasmuch as the remedy of the petitioner lies

before the Circle Officer, Sanjhauli, District-Rohtas under the

provisions of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the

case, I deem it fit and proper to grant liberty to the petitioner to

approach the respondent no. 6 i.e. the Circle Officer, Sanjhauli,

District-Rohtas, who shall take cognizance of the complaint of

the petitioner and act as per the provisions of the Bihar Public



Land Encroachment Act, 1956.
