Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order passed by the Bihar State Minority Commission dated 12.04.2016 and order passed by the Assistant Labour

As the writ petition is not maintainable against the private company, the same is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner, if so advised, he may take recourse of law before an appropriate forum.
