Case No. 671/2016, therefore, he is only looking for few installments to be fixed by this court so that petitioner can pay the entire dues.

No one appears on behalf of the Bank.

In the present facts and circumstances of the case, this court is of the opinion that the petitioner may approach the competent authority of the Bank or file an appropriate application in the recovery proceeding as the case may be with a prayer to allow him to pay all the dues in few installments



which will be considered by the Bank or Recovery Officer as
the case may be in accordance with the recovery policy of the
Bank and in accordance with law.

The Writ Application stands disposed of accordingly.
