2 29-01-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Tariyani P.S. Case No. 184 of 2018, disclosing offences under Section 30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation is of recovery of 186 liters liquor from a four wheeler parked near dairy shop of one Chunchun Rai. Petitioners are not named in the F.I.R.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioners is that during course of investigation they have been made accused in this case because their motorcycles were also parked near the dairy shop. Further, they have no criminal antecedents.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides, considering the above submission, this application is allowed. Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Incharge Additional District and Sessions Judge II-cum Special Judge, Sheohar, in connection with Tariyani P.S. Case No. 184 of 2018, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
