3 12-03-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Bhargama P.S. Case No. 70 of 2018, disclosing offences under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 379, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioners is that they have assaulted the informant causing injury to him.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioners is that there is case and counter case between the parties and all injuries are simple in nature, which will appear from Annexure-2. Further, they have no criminal antecedents.

Heard learned A.P.P. as well as learned counsel for the informant, they have opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitinoers.



Having heard both sides, considering the above submission, this application is allowed. Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Araria, in connection with Bhargama P.S. Case No. 70 of 2018, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
