2 04-02-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in connection with Sangrampur P.S. Case No.153 of 2017, registered for the offence punishable under Sections 363 and 366A of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation has been made that the victim was kidnapped by Nawal Mahto with the assistance given by the accused persons including the petitioners but in her statement under Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, she has not alleged anything against the petitioners, who are ladies.

Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the



case, let the petitioners, above-named, be released on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, East Champaran, Motihari, in connection with Sangrampur P.S. Case no.153 of 2017, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
