State.

The petitioner seeks bail in **Forbesganj P.S. Case**
No. 43 of 2018, instituted for the offence under Section(s) 392
of the Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is
not named in the written report. No Test Identification Parade
has been held. There is no recovery from conscious possession
of the petitioner. The name of petitioner has come in the
confessional statement of other co-accused persons. He further
submits that other co-accused persons have already been
granted bail by different coordinate Benches of this Court by
Annexure-6 series.

Petitioner is in custody since 26.1.2018.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed. Let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned **Chief Judicial Magistrate, Araria,** in connection with **Forbesganj P.S. Case No. 43 of 2018,** subject to the condition that both the bailors will be the close relatives of the petitioner.
