this writ application.

This court has however gone through the materials available on the record. It appears that petitioner has moved this court for setting aside the order as contained in Memo No. 406 dated 20.11.2018 passed by learned Sub-Divisional Officer, Phulparas by which the PDS license of the petitioner has been cancelled on the allegation of committing several acts of irregularities and illegalities.

Learned counsel for the State has pointed out that the impugned order has been passed after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and there is a statutory remedy of appeal available to the petitioner against the impugned order.



Taking note of the aforesaid facts that the petitioner has got a statutory remedy of appeal, this writ application is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the appellate authority, if so advised, in accordance with law within a period of 30 days from today.

In case, the petitioner prefers statutory appeal before the appellate authority within the aforesaid time, the same shall be considered on its own merit and keeping in mind that petitioner was pursuing his remedy before this court. It would be expected that the appellate authority considers and dispose of the appeal within the statutory period.

This writ application stands disposed of accordingly.
