3 21-11-2019 This Letters Patent Appeal has been preferred by the appellants for setting aside the order dated 5.11.2018 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in C.W.J.C. No.9576 of 2015 to the extent of observation that if any petition is filed before the Circle Officer to remove encroachment, the Circle Officer is competent to initiate a fresh proceeding in accordance with law under the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956.
