The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Amarpur P.S.
Case No.670 of 2018 registered under Sections 379 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code, Sections 4 and 40 of Bihar Mines and Minerals Concession Rules, 1972 and Sections 3, 6 and 8 of Illegal Mines and Minerals Transportation Storage Rules, 2003 and Section 15 of Forest Environment Act, 1986.

The petitioner is alleged to have been carrying 100 c.f.t. sand on his tractor bearing registration No.BR51B-4134 and its trailer bearing No.BR. No.BR51B-4135.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is ready to deposit the loss caused to the Department. Petitioner is driver and owner of the tractor.

Considering the aforesaid facts and nature of



allegation made against the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Banka in connection with Amarpur P.S. Case No.670 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
