ORAL ORDER

2 21-01-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application for grant of anticipatory bail arises out of Kashichak Police Station Case No. 141 of 2018, disclosing offence under Sections 272/273 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act').

There being bar under Section 76 (2) of the Act, this anticipatory bail application cannot be maintained and is, accordingly, dismissed.

However, considering the nature of allegation in the First Information Report, it is directed that if the petitioner surrenders before the Court below within four weeks from today



and applies for regular bail, his application shall be considered without being prejudiced by the present order of dismissal.
