The petitioner is in custody in connection with Gopalpur (Rangra) P.S. Case No. 248 of 2018 for the offence under Sections 307/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner himself surrendered in the Court below on 25.10.2018.
