ORAL ORDER

3. 04-04-2019 Heard Sri Ravindra Kumar Tiwary, learned counsel assisted by Sri Arbind Kumar Singh, learned counsel for petitioners, Sri Rajendra Singh, learned Addl. Public Prosecutor as well as Sri Gautam Kumar Yadav, learned counsel for the informant.

Four petitioners, apprehending their arrest in Siwan Muffasil P.S. Case No. 602 of 2018 registered for offence under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 504, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, have prayed for grant of bail in the event of their arrest or surrender.



It was submitted by learned counsel for petitioners that the injuries, shown to be caused by petitioners, were not grievous in nature. It has also been argued that there is no allegation against the petitioners regarding falsely obtaining huge amount from the informant and others. He has also argued that petitioners are having clean antecedent. Accordingly, a prayer has been made for granting anticipatory bail.

However, on going through the F.I.R. itself, which suggests that petitioners were participants with main accused, there is no reason to extend the privilege of anticipatory bail.

The prayer for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
