ORAL ORDER

2 11-02-2019 Following is the relief, which the petitioner is
seeking:-

“To issue a writ of mandamus or any other writ or writs, direction or directions, commanding upon the respondents to record the land, in question, in respect of R.S. Khata No. 85/6 and 120, fully detailed in para no. 3 to this petition which has been exclusively recorded in the name of Chalitra Bhgat, now dead, the father of respondent no. 9 and 10 though the



petitioner has got 1/3rd share in the said land of
Khata No. 85/6 and 120.”

Apparently, it is purely question of title, which the
petitioner intends to raise in the present writ application, which
is not permissible.

This application is disposed of with the only
observation that the petitioner shall be at liberty to approach
competent court of civil jurisdiction for the relief, which the
petitioner has sought for in the present writ application.
