2 15-02-2019 Heard the parties.

In the present writ application, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondent authority to remove the encroachment over the public land having its Khata No.141 (old)/295 (new), Khesra No.658 (old)/1262 (new) situated at Mauza Boraj, Thana No.15.

Earlier also an encroachment proceeding was initiated for removing the encroachers from the public land in question, which is evident from Annexures 1 and 2 to the present application. After removal of encroachment from the public



land, again the land in question has been encroached by the Respondent Nos.8 and 9.

Considering the submissions made above on behalf of the petitioner, the petitioner is directed to file a fresh application before the Respondent No.2 i.e. The District Magistrate-cum-Collector, Samastipur. The Respondent No.2 shall consider the case/application of the petitioner and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law within a period of four months from the date of filing of such application.

With the aforesaid observation and direction, the present writ application stands disposed of.
