2 16-01-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Pusa
P.S. Case No. 103 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable
under Section 30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act,
2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. He further submits that
petitioner is in custody in connection with seizure of 18 liters of
liquor from a tempo. He submits that the petitioner is only
passenger and has no concern with the alleged recovery. In this
case petitioner is in custody since 26.11.2018.

Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal
antecedent and he is in custody in this case since 26.11.2018, let



the petitioner named above is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Learned 3rd Additional Sessions Judge-cum-special Judge, Excise Act, Samastipur in connection with Pusa P.S. Case No. 103 of 2018.
