3 28-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are in custody in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No. 517 of 2018 for the offences under Sections 448, 341, 323, 324, 326, 302, 337, 338 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent and they are in custody since 21.10.2018. He further submits that there is no allegation of any overt act against the petitioners and petitioners are ladies. He further submits that similarly circumstanced other co-



accused have been granted bail.

Considering the fact that petitioners are ladies and there is no allegation of any overt act against the petitioners, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners, let the petitioners, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-2nd, Danapur, Patna in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No. 517 of 2018.
