ORAL ORDER

2 19-02-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No. 331 of 2017, disclosing offences under Sections 304(B), 201, 302, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner, who happens to be *devar* of the deceased, is of causing dowry death of the deceased.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that no specific allegation of demand or cruelty against the petitioner and the husband of the deceased is in custody. Further, the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, considering the above submission, this application is allowed. Let the petitioner, above



named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.-II, Danapur, in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No. 331 of 2017, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
