Petitioners are in custody in connection with Katoria
P.S. Case No. 162 of 2018 for the offence under sections 457,
380 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that
petitioners have no criminal antecedent. He submits that name

Nothing was recovered from the possession of the
