Though, the petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for directing the respondent authorities to institute the first information report against respondent no.6 under Section 384, 386 and 387 of the Indian Penal Code, as the Station House Officer refused to register the first information report and when a written complaint was made to the Superintendent of Police, Nalanda, Bihar Sharif, he also failed either to investigate the case himself or get the case investigated through some subordinate officer, after



some arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the writ petition may be disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a complaint under Sections 190 and 200 of the Code of Criminal Procedure before the court of jurisdictional Magistrate for the redressal of his grievance.

Leave is granted.

The writ petition is disposed of.
