ORAL ORDER

2 23-07-2019 Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the Deputy Inspector General, Bihar Military Police (DIG, BMP for short), North Mandal, Muzaffarpur is a necessary party in the instant proceedings since appeal of the petitioner against the punishment order dated 16.08.2010 terminating the petitioner's services is pending consideration before the said DIG, BMP.
