2 15-02-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
counsel representing the complainant and learned APP for the
State.

Petitioner in the present case is seeking anticipatory bail
in connection with Complaint Case No. 1418(c)/15 in which
cognizance has been taken for the offences punishable under
Sections 406, 420 323 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this
petitioner was acting on behalf of the disclosed principle as it
would be evident from the statement of the complainant on solemn
affirmation itself that the complainant was fully aware of the fact
that the petitioner was acting an agent of Kolkata Beer Industries
Ltd. and the money was being given to the petitioner for deposit in
the said company. It is not the case of the complaint that the



petitioner has not deposited the money to misappropriate the same for his own purpose. The complainant states that he was being given receipt thereof.

Learned counsel for the complainant has though opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail but in the given facts and circumstances of the case, considering the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, this court is willing to extend the benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Let the petitioner above named, in case of his arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing of bail bonds of Rs. 15,000/- (rupees fifteen thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M., 3rd, Jamui in connection with Complaint Case No. 1418(c)/15.
