5 14-08-2019 The present writ petition has been filed for payment of arrears of revised pension, gratuity and earned leave on the basis of revised salary, on account of grant of the benefit of A.C.P.

The learned counsel for the respondent- State has filed a supplementary affidavit, wherein it has been stated that not only the entire aforesaid amount of outstanding retiral dues have already been sanctioned but most of the amounts have already been paid.



Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the present writ petition stands disposed off with a direction to the respondents to make payment of the balance outstanding amount within a period of four weeks from today, failing which the respondent- authorities shall be liable for penal action.
