ORAL ORDER

2 03-05-2019 After some argument, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the writ application may be disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail the statutory remedy of appeal under the provisions of the Bihar Targeted Public Distribution System (Control) Order, 2016.

Learned counsel for the State has no objection to the petitioner's applying for an appropriate remedy.

In the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this writ application is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to prefer a statutory appeal before the District Magistrate, Gaya (Respondent No.3) within a period of 30 days from today. On petitioner's filing a statutory appeal, the same will be considered by Respondent No.3 and will be disposed of within a period of



60 days from the date of filing of the complaint by a reasoned order. The petitioner shall be at liberty to take all such pleas which are available to him. In case, if a question of limitation arises, the same will be considered keeping in mind that the petitioner was pursuing his remedy before this Court.
