3 28-05-2019 The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the case of the petitioners is squarely covered by a judgment of the Hon'ble Apex Court rendered in the case of **Mukesh Kumar & Anr. vs. The State of Bihar & Others**, reported in 2017 (5) SCC 383, hence, the respondent no.6 be directed to



consider the case of the petitioners in light of the said judgment and take a decision within specified time frame.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondent no.6 by filing a representation, annexing the aforesaid judgment of the Hon'ble Apex Court rendered in the case of **Mukesh Kumar** (supra), within a period of four weeks from today, which shall be disposed of by a reasoned order within a period of eight weeks thereafter by the respondent no.6.
