APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 323, 341, 447, 326A, 379/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case in short is that daughter of the
informant namely Shilpa Kumari was burnt by pouring TEJAB
by accused persons.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation
of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The
petitioner is in custody since 11-12-2018. Charge sheet has
already been submitted. The petitioner has been falsely
implicated in the present case. There is admitted land dispute
between the parties. The petitioner is a lady. The other co-



accused namely Ramjee Pandey with similar allegation has been granted bail by this court vide order dated 22-11-2018 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 66500 of 2018.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sheohar in connection with Purnahiya P.S. Case No. 10 of 2018.
