15 for the State.

2. Pursuant to the order dated 27.08.2019, the District
Magistrate, Patna; the Director, Higher Education, Government of
Bihar and the Director, Bihar Rashtra Bhasha Parishad, are present
for reasons recorded in the order.

3. Show cause has been filed by them.



4. From the same, it transpires that claim of the petitioner for appointment on compassionate ground has been accepted and letter of appointment has also been issued to him as contained in Memo No.1678 dated 26.09.2019 under the signature of the Director, Higher Education Department, Government of Bihar.

5. The Appointment Letter, copy of which has been brought on record, has been handed over to the petitioner, who incidentally, is present in Court.
