Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Section 341, 323,
308, 379, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the general and omnibus nature of
allegation, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their
arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of
thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on
bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand)
each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction
of the Court-below where the case is pending in connection with



Nabinagar Police Station Case No. 352 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
