In this case, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory  
bail in connection with G.O. Case No.9 of 2015, registered for  
the offence punishable under Section 47(a) of Bihar Excise Act.

43.200 liters of foreign liquor has been recovered  
from the rented shop being run by Mr. Awadhesh Kumar Singh.  
The petitioner claims to be the landlord of the shop and has no  
connection with the alleged recovery of liquor.

Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the  
case, let the petitioner, above-named, be released on anticipatory  
bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned  
Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on



furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jhanjharpur, in connection with G.O. Case No. 9 of 2015, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
