It is submitted by counsel for the petitioner that the

petitioner was denied selection though she was valid candidate

It is further submitted that from the center SC/ST category candidate was to be appointed/selected but candidate belonging to OBC category has been appointed. It is alleged that selection was on the basis of extraneous consideration. It is submitted that against selection of candidate, petitioner would approach the appropriate authority under the guideline with her grievance in respect of selection in question.

In view of such submissions, this court only observes that authority concerned would examine the issue in accordance with law after hearing the parties.

Writ petition is disposed off.
