The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case he is granted liberty to file a representation before the respondent no. 4 and the respondent no. 4 may be directed to dispose off the representation of the petitioner within a specified time frame.

Accordingly, it is directed that the petitioner shall file a representation before the respondent no. 4 regarding his grievances raised in the writ petition within a period of four weeks from today and the respondent no. 4 is directed to dispose



off the same within a period of eight weeks thereafter considering the judgment passed by the learned Division Bench of this Court dated 14.05.2018 passed in L.P.A. No. 295 of 2015 (Vijay Shankar Rai & Ors. vs. The State of Bihar & Ors.)
