State.

The petitioners seek bail in **Muffasil P.S. Case No. 75 of 2016**, instituted for the offence under Section (s) 498A and 304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are brothers-in-law of the deceased. In the written report there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners.

Petitioners are in custody since 18.8.2018 having clean antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioners for grant of bail is allowed.

Let the petitioners above named, be released on bail on



furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of **learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nawada**, in connection with **Muffasil P.S. Case No. 75 of 2016 (Sessions Trial No. 445 of 2018/57 of 2018)**, subject to the condition that both the bailors will be the close relatives of the petitioners.
