APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 15, 18, 20, 22 of N.D.P.S. Act.

Allegation is that 2.200 kg opium is recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 15.09.2018 and has got no
criminal antecedent. Charge sheet has been submitted in the
case. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged
against the petitioner. It is alleged that 2.200 kg opium is
recovered. Same is below the commercial quantity. There is no
compliance of Sections 42 and 50 of N.D.P.S. Act.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the



petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, N.D.P.S. Act, Gaya in connection with Barachatti (Mohanpur) P.S. case No.610 of 2018.
