Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of Rajpur P.S. Case No. 243 of 2018 for the offence under Sections 147, 148, 341, 323, 325, 307, 379 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

From the First Information Report, it appears that the occurrence took place because of some dispute over irrigation of land of the informant and the accused persons. Though there is allegation of opening fire by petitioner No.2 with a country made pistol, it is evident from the First



Information Report that no one sustained any injury of that kind.

Considering the above, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioners above named, in the event of their arrest/surrender within six weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned A.C.J.M.-VII, Buxar, in Rajpur P.S. Case No. 243 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioners shall present themselves before the Police/Court, as the case may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on their part to appear before the Court on two consecutive occasions, their bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
