2 14-02-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Town,
Samastipur P.S. Case No. 230 of 2018 for the offenses under
Sections 395 and 397 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The alleged recovery of
silver brick cannot be connected with the commission of the
offence in question for the reason that the same brick contains
the seal of Sri Sai Nath Probation Centre, Sabzi Bazar,
Begusarai. The purity certificate and receipt of such silver brick
falsify the allegation levelled against the petitioner.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has no
criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 21.9.2018, let the



petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge-3rd, Samastipur in connection with Town, Samastipur P.S. Case No. 230 of 2018.
