2 13-02-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in
connection with Beur P.S. Case No. 251 of 2018, disclosing
offences under Sections 304(B), 201, 34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Allegation against the petitioner, who happens to be
the maternal uncle of the deceased, is dowry death.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is
that no specific allegation has been attributed against the
petitioner, rather main allegation is against the husband of the
deceased. Further, he has no criminal antecedent.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, considering the above
submission, this application is allowed. Let the petitioner, above
named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court



below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.J. VIII Cum A.C.J.M., Patna, in connection with Beur P.S. Case No. 251 of 2018, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
