State.

The petitioner seeks bail in **Deoria P.S. Case No. 95
of 2018 (Sessions Trial No. 711 of 2018)**, instituted for the
offence under Section(s) 395 of the Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is
not named in the written report. There is no recovery from
possession of the petitioner. No Test Identification Parade has
been held. The name of petitioner has come in the confessional
statement of co-accused Mukesh Kumar. He further submits
that co-accused Deepak Kumar with similar allegation has
already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated
20.12.2018 passed in Cr. Misc. 76930 of 2018.

Petitioner is in custody since 29.7.2018.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed. Let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned **Additional Sessions Judge 13, Muzaffarpur**, in connection with **Deoria P.S. Case No. 95 of 2018 (Sessions Trial No. 711 of 2018)**, subject to the condition that both the bailors will be the close relatives of the petitioner.
