The petitioner is aggrieved by the non-implementation of the report of the Fitment Committee with respect to the employees under the National Health Mission regarding their salary and other allowances. Several representations to that effect has been made before the Chief Secretary, Development Commissioner and Principal Secretary, Health Department, Govt. of Bihar respectively by such employees of the National Health Mission, but those representations have not yet been acted upon. The petitioner expects that the recommendations of the Fitment Committee dated 10.02.2017 be implemented at the earliest.

Considering the aforesaid facts, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the petitioner to make a fresh representation before the Principal Secretary, Health Department, Government of Bihar, Patna (respondent No. 3), detaining grievances of the employees within a period of four weeks from today, who, on receipt of the same, shall pass a



reasoned order, in accordance with law, within a period of three months thereafter.

With the aforesaid observation/direction, the writ petition stands disposed off.
