2 14-02-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since
17.12.2018 in a case registered for the offence punishable under
Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is alleged that from the possession of the petitioner,
27 litres of illicit Nepali liquor were recovered.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedent,
statement to that effect has been made in paragraph 3 of the
petition.

Learned APP submits that the recovery has been made
from the possession of the petitioner.



Considering the quantity of recovery and the period under custody, coupled with the statement made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedent, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge II -cum- Special Judge, Excise Act, Sitamarhi in connection with G.O. No. 158 of 2018.
