3 18-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are languishing in custody for the
offence punishable under Section 304B/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Husband of the deceased is not an accused in this
case. Father-in-law has already been allowed bail by a
coordinate Bench of this Court in Cr. Misc. No.71834 of 2018
vide Annexure-2. The petitioners are mother-in-law and Gotani
of the deceased.

Learned counsel for the informant opposed the
prayer for bail.

Considering the facts aforesaid especially the fact



that the petitioners are female, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with Chand P.S. Case No.176 of 2018, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below.

(b) The petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
