2 27-02-2019 The petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his

arrest in connection with Hisua P.S. Case No. 251 of 2018,

dated 01.09.2018, instituted for the offences under Section

30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

15 litres of liquor is said to have been recovered

from a bush in front of the house of the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has

submitted that the place from where the recovery has been



made is accessible from all sides as it is without an enclosure.

Since there is no recovery from the possession/constructive possession of the petitioner above named and he does not have any criminal antecedents, he, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of the present order, is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Addl. District Judge-II, Nawada in connection with Hisua P.S. Case No. 251 of 2018, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
