ORAL ORDER

2 25-02-2019 Petitioners seek bail in anticipation of their arrest in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No. 91 of 2015, arising out of C.R. Case No. 507 of 2018, T.R.No. 2897 of 2018, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 363, 364, 354, 367, 368 of the Indian Penal Code but cognizance has been taken under Sections 365, 366 and 367/34 IPC.

Petitioner Nos. 1 and 2 are brothers-in-law of the victim and petitioner Nos. 3 and 4 are villagers and allegation against them is that while victim was returning from the court they have kidnapped her and threatened her to compromise a maintenance case filed by her.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioners is



that police after investigation has submitted final form but cognizance has been taken on protest petition.

Heard learned APP also.

Having heard both sides and in the facts and circumstances, let petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of six weeks from the receipt of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Madhubani, in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No. 91 of 2015, corresponding to C.R.No. 597 of 2018, T.R.No. 2897 of 2018 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure and further condition that one of the bailors of the petitioners shall be a local person having sufficient immoveable properties within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.
