3 26-04-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since
09.11.2018 in a case for the offence registered under Sections
363, 365, 120(B)/34 of the IPC. Later on, Sections 302 and 201
of the IPC were also added.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that the F.I.R.
named accused persons committed murder of the deceased
Navin Yadav husband of the informant after kidnapping him.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.
Charge sheet has been submitted in the present case. There is no
allegation of tampering with the witnesses alleged against the



petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. There is no eye witness to the alleged occurrence. Except for this, there is no other material against the petitioner in the present case.

On behalf of the learned counsel for the State, it has been submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M. Madhepura, in connection with Madhepura P.S. Case No. 876 of 2018.
