ORAL ORDER

2 26-02-2019 Heard learned counsel for petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

Petitioner, who is in custody, seeks bail in
connection with Chhauradano P.S. Case No. 362 of 2018
registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation is recovery of 1 ½ liters of Nepali wine
from the factory of the petitioner.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner
that he is innocent and has committed no offence. He has been
falsely implicated in this case due to suspicion. Nothing was
recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Petitioner is in
custody since 01.01.2019. Petitioner is accused in one more case
in identical nature.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge Excise, Motihari, East Champaran, in connection with Chhauradano P.S. Case No. 362 of 2018, subject to conditions:

- (1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.
- (2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be represented on each and every date fixed by the court.
- (3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
- (4) If the petitioner is found involved in similar nature of offences, after his release on bail the trial court shall take steps to cancel his bail bonds.
