3 02-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 363, 366A/34 of the Indian
Penal Code.

The statement of the victim girl recorded under
Section 164 Cr.P.C. would reveal that she never made any
protest while the petitioner carried her on bike to Sitamarhi and
thereafter to Muzaffarpur and then to Samastipur and thereafter
by train to Delhi.

Considering the statement of the victim girl, it appears
that she was a consenting party and nothing more is alleged
against the petitioner, let the petitioner, above named, be
released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees
Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to



the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Pupari Police Station Case No. 447 of 2018, with the following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned court-below having immovable property.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
