2 25-02-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners are in custody in connection with Brahmpur P.S. Case No. 431/2017, for the offence under Sections 366(A), 120(B) and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners have no criminal antecedent. Learned counsel for the petitioners has referred the statement of the victim under Section 164 Cr.P.C. and submits that the victim has admitted that she accompanied Motak Paswan at her own volition and there is no allegation of any overt act or any act which shall constitute offence against these petitioners. Similarly situated co-accused persons have been granted bail.



Considering the totality of the fact and circumstances indicated hereinabove, the petitioners named above, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000 (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Buxar in connection with Brahmpur P.S. Case No. 431/2017.
