It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that though there is an order dated 08.11.2011 passed in MJC No. 1804 of 2010 whereby this Court had given direction to the officer of ADM rank to monitor the progress of Title Suit No. 634 of 2011 but the case is moving in dilly dally manner.

From the last order dated 21.06.2018 it appears that one witness has been examined and cross-examined. The progress



of the case is not satisfactory. The Lower Court should have endeavoured for early disposal of the case as even after lapse of so many years, the progress of the case is, completion of deposition of single witness.

This Court gives direction to the Court below to expedite the trial and the State authority especially the District Magistrate is directed to ensure that the witnesses from the side of the State should remain present on the date fixed.
